RVC Juniors

RVC Juniors is a developmental volleyball program for girls and boys ages 8-18, drawing players primarily from Central Virginia. RVC Juniors teams compete from January through July in tournaments sanctioned by USA Volleyball, which governs volleyball in the United States.

USA Junior Volleyball

Volleyball is the ultimate team sport – the USA Men’s and Women’s National Volleyball Teams have achieved their international excellence through a mastery of teamwork including leadership, cooperation and self-discipline, coupled with skill in the physical elements of the game.

USA Junior Volleyball is the gateway to an exciting future, including Junior Nationals, the U.S. Olympic Festival, the World University Games and ultimately the National Teams. The desire to develop the skills that allow you to be your best as an athlete and individual is all that is required.

USA Junior Volleyball, administered through the regions of USA Volleyball, offers young athletes the opportunity to develop skills through competition in volleyball. Along the way, friendships are made and lessons learned about winning and losing, leading and following, hard work and dedication, and the value of participation!

The only equipment needed is a good pair of volleyball shoes (gum soled) and a pair of knee pads.

RVC Mission Statement

Richmond Volleyball Club is a nonprofit organization dedicated to developing athletes of all ages for amateur volleyball competition. The purpose of RVC is to promote interest in the sport of volleyball, provide training in the skills and techniques of volleyball, and foster teamwork, sportsmanship and an appreciation for health and wellness.

RVC Juniors History

Since 1990, teams from the Richmond area have called RVC home. During that time, the club has developed into one of the premier programs on the East Coast.

RVC Juniors’ teams have an impressive record in the Old Dominion Region winning 30 Girls and 41 Boys Regional Championships. Moreover, RVC teams are also improving on the national scene. Teams have been competing in the USAV Junior National Championships since 1993, with a second place at the 2000 Boys’ 18’s tournament and a third place finish at the 2007 Girls’ 17’s tournament. Last

year, RVC sent six boys’ teams to the Junior Nationals Championships in Atlanta, GA and one girl’s team to Miami, FL. We look forward to continued success in the future.



About Richmond Volleyball Club

The Richmond Volleyball Club, a private, non profit organization, was founded in 1981 when two area leagues, TRAVL and the Fan League, merged and opened what is now RVC East at 3300 West Marshall Street.

The popularity of league play at RVC grew tremendously during the 1980’s, resulting in a much-needed expansion. In the fall of 1991, RVC West, with six courts at 1907 Westmoreland Street, opened its doors to the membership. The two locations house a total of ten courts, one of the largest volleyball-dedicated facilities in the world.

Five full-time and approximately twenty part-time employees operate the club. A volunteer Board of Directors, consisting of nine members selected from the general membership, guides RVC management.

Currently, RVC has nearly 3,000 active members and 240 teams participating in evening recreational leagues from Sunday through Friday. The club also hosts many adult and juniors USAV tournaments and four multi-day events including the Monument City Classic in mid January, the Boys’ East Coast and South Atlantic Championships Memorial Day weekend and the High School Volleyball Showcase Labor Day weekend. In addition, RVC sponsors skills clinics, referee training and other special events related to the promotion of volleyball, the sport for a lifetime.

The player and at least one parent must attend one of the sessions. Please bring: a **payment of \$200** (check or major credit card for RVC membership (\$50), processing (\$25) and tryout (\$25) fees, and fundraiser deposit (\$100). You will also need to bring **proof of insurance, and proof of a completed and paid USAV membership** (New USAV members go to <https://webpoint.usavolleyball.org/wp/memberships/join.asp?mbr ChapterID=25976> and existing USAV members go to <https://webpoint.usavolleyball.org/wp15/IntraLock/Login.asp>) **The player and a parent/guardian must sign all forms on registration day!**

To avoid long lines, register early! You may print forms from our website at www.rvc.net or pick up a registration packet at the RVC office after October 22. *Completed forms must be brought to one of the registration sessions. Faxed or mailed forms will not be accepted!*

NOTE: There is a \$50 late fee for registrations submitted after November 1 (First time members are granted exception provided space on a team is available.).

Please note that any player or family member not in good financial standing with RVC will not be allowed to register for the upcoming season until that standing is rectified.

Age Definitions

18 & Under Players who were born on or after **September 1, 1991** or were high school students in the 12th grade or below during some part of the current school year (**born on or after September 1, 1990**).

17 & Under Players who were born on or after **9/1/92**

16 & Under Players who were born on or after **9/1/93**

15 & Under Players who were born on or after **9/1/94**

14 & Under Players who were born on or after **9/1/95**

13 & Under Players who were born on or after **9/1/96**

12 & Under Players who were born on or after **9/1/97**

Girls Team and Fee Structure

RVC Juniors for girls will have four levels of teams: City, State, Zonal and National. With the exception of City Teams there is only one team per age group.

Team dues include uniforms, court rental, equipment, education, coaches' stipend, administrative costs, and a volleyball.

The team dues are in addition to registration fees and **do not** include the \$40 USAV membership which must be paid prior to registration

CITY TEAM DUES (Non Travel)

12 & under division -----\$300 per participant**

13, 14, 15, 16 and under divisions--\$325 per participant**

Teams will participate in a Sunday afternoon league and may also play in local USAV tournaments and will carry twelve players on the roster. You can expect **total fees to be \$300 - \$450** (including team dues) depending on tournament schedule outside the Sunday afternoon competitions.

STATE TEAM DUES (Travel Team)

15,16,17 divisions-----\$525 per participant**.

Teams play within VA including DC including multi-day events and will have up to twelve players on the roster.

You can expect **total fees to be \$900 - \$1300** (including team dues) depending upon tournament schedule.

ZONAL TEAM DUES (Travel Team)

14, 15, 16, 17, 18 divisions-----\$660 per participant**

Teams play both in and out of the state including multi day events with up to twelve players on the roster. You can expect **total fees to be \$1600 - \$2000** (including team dues) depending upon the tournament schedule.

NATIONAL TEAM DUES (Travel Team)

14, 15, 16, 17, 18 divisions-----\$765 per participant**

Teams play a limited ODR schedule but travel extensively outside of the region and will carry up to twelve players on the roster. They will also attend at least one national championship. You can expect **total fees of \$2000 - \$4000** (including team dues) depending upon tournament schedule.

Boys Team and Fee Structure

RVC Juniors for boys will have four levels of teams: City, Regional, Zonal and National. There is only one National and Zonal team per age group.

Team dues include uniforms, court rental, equipment, education, coaches' stipend, administrative costs, and a volleyball.

The team dues are in addition to registration fees and **do not** include the \$40 USAV membership which must be paid prior to registration

CITY TEAM DUES (Non Travel)

12 & under division -----\$300 per participant**

14 & under division -----\$325 per participant**.

City teams will participate in a Sunday afternoon league. They may also play in local USAV sanctioned tournaments and will carry twelve players on the roster. You can expect **total fees to be \$300 - \$450** (including team dues) depending on tournament schedule outside the Sunday afternoon competitions.

REGIONAL TEAM DUES (Travel Team)

14, 15,16,17,18 divisions-----\$490 per participant**

Regional teams play within the Old Dominion Region participating in USAV sanctioned tournaments and will carry twelve players on the roster. It could include one multi-day event (Boys' East Coast Championship).

Your can expect **total fees to be \$800 - \$950** (including team dues) depending upon team's tournament schedule.

ZONAL TEAM DUES (Travel Team)

14, 15, 16, 17, 18 divisions-----\$675 per participant**

Zonal teams play in region and will also play in multi-day tournaments out of state and will carry up to twelve players on the roster. You can expect **total fees to be \$1600 - \$2500** (including team dues) depending upon team's tournament schedule.

NATIONAL TEAM DUES (Travel Team)

15, 16, 17, 18 divisions-----\$750 per participant**

National teams play a limited regional schedule but travel extensively outside of the region and will carry up to twelve players on the roster. They will also attend at least one national championship. You can expect **total fees to be \$2000 - \$4000** (including team dues) depending upon team's schedule.
