RVC Juniors is a developmental volleyball program for girls and boys ages 8-18, drawing players primarily from Central Virginia. RVC Juniors teams compete from January through July in tournaments sanctioned by USA Volleyball, which governs volleyball in the United States.

USA Junior Volleyball

Volleyball is the ultimate team sport – the USA Men’s and Women’s National Volleyball Teams have achieved their international excellence through a mastery of teamwork including leadership, cooperation and self-discipline, coupled with skill in the physical elements of the game.

USA Junior Volleyball is the gateway to an exciting future, including Junior Nationals, the U.S. Olympic Festival, the World University Games and ultimately the National Teams. All you need is the desire to compete, have fun, learn to work in a team environment, and a strong work ethic.

USA Junior Volleyball, administered through the regions of USA Volleyball, offers young athletes the opportunity to develop skills through competition in volleyball. Along the way, friendships are made and lessons learned about winning and losing, leading and following, hard work and dedication, and the value of participation!

The only equipment needed is a good pair of volleyball shoes and a pair of knee pads.

RVC Juniors History

Since 1990, teams from the Richmond area have called RVC home. During that time, the club has developed into one of the premier programs on the East Coast.

RVC Juniors’ teams have an impressive record in the Old Dominion Region winning 30 Girls and 41 Boys Regional Championships. Moreover, RVC teams are also improving on the national scene. Teams have been competing in the USAV Junior National Championships since 1993. We look forward to continued success in the future.

Richmond Volleyball Club is a nonprofit organization dedicated to developing athletes of all ages for amateur volleyball competition. The purpose of RVC is to promote interest in the sport of volleyball, provide training in the skills and techniques of volleyball, and foster teamwork, sportsmanship and an appreciation for health and wellness.

The new Byrdhill location houses a total of 12 courts, one of the largest volleyball specific facilities in the world.

Currently, RVC has nearly 2,700 active members and 240 teams participating in evening recreational leagues from Sunday through Friday. The club also hosts many adult and juniors USAV tournaments and four multi-day events including the Monument City Classic in mid January, the Boys’ East Coast and South Atlantic Championships. In addition, RVC sponsors skills clinics, referee training, private volleyball instruction and other special events related to the promotion of volleyball, the sport for a lifetime.

How Do RVC Financials Work?

- \$200.00 Collected at Registration.
 - \$100.00 non refundable tryout fee
 - \$100.00 fundraising deposit, which the athlete may earn back.
- \$50.00 USAV membership fee.
 - If your child makes a travel team they will need to be a member of USAV in order to participate in their first team's practice. Memberships are 50.00 for the season. Links can be found on the www.rvc.net website.
- Team Dues.
 - Once your child has verbally committed to participate on a particular team, you will receive an invoice for total amount of team dues. Team Dues are thoroughly explained to the right.
- Tournament Expenses
 - As your child's season continues, RVC will mail you itemized invoices, once a month, dependant upon the exact amount for your child and their team to compete in USAV tournaments. This will include Tournament registration fees, hotel costs, airline tickets, van rentals, and all coach's expenses associated with the tournament.
 - Local ODR tournaments cost \$150.00 per team. USAV Multi-Day tournaments range from \$300.00 - \$725.00. USAV Junior Nationals cost \$900.00 per team.



Girls Team and Fee Structure

RVC Juniors for girls will have four levels of teams: City, State, Zonal and National. We try to offer a level for all to participate. National is our most competitive level, teams compete in tournaments all over the country. City is our developmental league, and teams only compete here in the city of Richmond.

Team dues include uniforms, court rental, equipment, education, coaches' salary, administrative costs, and a volleyball (excluding City teams).

The team dues are in addition to registration fees and **do not** include the \$50 USAV membership (which must be paid for travel teams).

CITY TEAM DUES-\$300 per participant

Teams will participate in a Sunday afternoon league and will carry 10-12 players on the roster. Season runs from January through May. You can expect **total fees to be \$300.** (not including RVC registration fees) This amount is subject to increase if the team decides to participate in any USAV tournaments in the Richmond area.

STATE TEAM DUES-\$495 per participant**.

Teams play within VA including DC including multi-day events and will have up to twelve players on the roster. The State season runs from December to June. You can expect **total fees to be \$900-\$1300** (not including RVC registration fees) depending upon tournament schedule.

ZONAL TEAM DUES-\$695 per participant**

Teams play up and down the east coast, including multi day events with up to twelve players on the roster. The Zonal season runs from December to July. You can expect **total fees to be \$1600-\$2800** (not including RVC registration fees) depending upon tournament schedule.

NATIONAL TEAM DUES-\$795 per participant**

Teams play in tournaments all across the country and will carry up to twelve players on the roster. They will also attend at least one national championship. You can expect **total fees of \$2300-\$4300** (not including RVC registration fees) depending upon tournament schedule.

Boys Team and Fee Structure

RVC Juniors for boys will have four levels of teams: City, Regional, Zonal, and National. We try to offer a level for all to participate. National is our most competitive level, teams compete in tournaments all over the country. City is our developmental league, and teams only compete here in the city of Richmond.

Team dues include uniforms, court rental, equipment, education, coach's salary, administrative costs, and a volleyball (excluding City teams).

The team dues are in addition to registration fees and **do not** include the \$50 USAV membership (which must be paid for travel teams).

CITY TEAM DUES- \$300 per participant.

****Offered for 14 and under boys only****City teams will participate in a Sunday afternoon league and will carry up to twelve players on the roster. You can expect **total fees to be \$300** (not including RVC registration fees) This amount is subject to increase if the team decided to participate in any USAV tournaments in the Richmond area.

REGIONAL TEAM DUES- \$495 per participant**

Regional teams play within the State of Virginia and will carry up to twelve players on the roster. Team will compete in one multi-day event (Boys' East Coast Championship). You can expect **total fees to be \$800-\$950** (not including RVC registration fees) depending upon tournament schedule.

ZONAL TEAM DUES- \$695 per participant**

Zonal teams play in tournaments up and down the east coast, possibly USAV Junior Nationals, and will carry up to twelve players on the roster. You can expect **total fees to be \$1600-\$2800** (not including RVC registration fees) depending upon tournament schedule.

NATIONAL TEAM DUES- \$795 per participant**

National teams play a limited regional schedule and travel all across the nation to participate in tournaments. Teams will carry up to twelve players on the roster. They will also attend USAV Junior National Championship at the culmination of their season. You can expect **total fees to be \$2300-\$4300** (not including RVC registration fees) depending upon tournament schedule.

Age Definitions

18 & Under Players who were born on or after **September 1, 1993 or** were high school students in the 12th grade or below during some part of the current school year (**born on or after September 1, 1992**).

17 & Under Players who were born on or after **9/1/94**

16 & Under Players who were born on or after **9/1/95**

15 & Under Players who were born on or after **9/1/96**

14 & Under Players who were born on or after **9/1/97**

13 & Under Players who were born on or after **9/1/98**

12 & Under Players who were born on or after **9/1/99**
