# RVC Juniors Coaches Code of Ethics



All RVC Coaches shall follow the following code of ethics:

- All coaches must be a minimum of 17 years of age and registered members of the USAV Old Dominion Region.
- All Coaches must be certified (minimum IMPACT) by the USAV to coach in any tournament.
- All Coaches must inform both their players and their player's parents or guardian of the USAV transfer policy. This policy prohibits a player from transferring clubs during the season once that player has represented a club in a USAV sanctioned tournament.
- Coaches will provide a positive role model and atmosphere in practices and matches, acting courteously, respectfully, and politely to all players, parents, other coaches, and officials.
  - ▶ Including not consuming alcoholic beverages in the presence of your athletes or coming in contact them while under the influence of alcohol or any effects of alcohol consumption.
  - ▶ Including acting in a responsible moral manner to include not discussing in the presence of your athletes activities that may take place between consenting adults.
  - ▶ Including refraining from the use of inappropriate or foul language in the presence of your athletes. (You should not do anything you would not do in front of your own child or parents)
- Coaches will work with and develop every member of every team, not just the starters.
- No Coach will supply or condone the use of drugs, alcohol, or tobacco.
- No coach will participate, require, or condone any action by their players, which is illegal under either the civil or criminal code.
- A registered adult coach must be present at all practices, during team supervised travel, and during competition.
- No coach shall allow, encourage, condone, or require any behavior that threatens a player's VHSL, USAV, or NCAA eligibility.
- Once a player has committed to a team or club for the season, either verbally or in writing, no coach may initiate any contact with an athlete for the purpose of persuading them to leave their present club or team. This would include players under the direction of a coach, or parents under the direction of a coach, contacting an athlete for the purpose of persuading them to leave the club/team to which they have committed. This does not prohibit you from directing someone to the club director or website regarding information about RVC tryouts, practices, organization, etc., if it is requested the player or his/her parents or guardians. The information cannot relate to any promise, future considerations, or inducements to leave their present club or team.
- No coach shall have any discussions with a parent or athlete concerning another coach.
- All coaches must sign this code of ethics to coach for the Richmond Volleyball Club and any violation of this code may result in sanctions being taken against you. These sanctions may extend to the loss of eligibility of the coach, player, team, or club.
